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SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondent-Bank does not dispute that the loan account has been settled and closed since the entire due amount has been paid by the petitioner-borrower.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the title deed deposited with the respondent-Bank has not yet been released.
3. If an application is made to the respondent-Bank within a period of 15 days, the same would be considered in its right perspective by the Bank and a speaking order would be passed, in case the Bank chooses to deny supply of the original deed. Otherwise the deed would be handed over to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, petition stands disposed of.
