1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, for issuance of directions to respondent nos.2 and 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in their peaceful life at the behest of respondents No.4 to 6 and their relatives.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that both the petitioners are major and have married against the wishes of respondent nos.4 to 6. They apprehend danger from respondent nos.4 to 6. Their marriage certificate evidencing their marriage is on record as Annexure P-3. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 13.05.2025 (Annexure P-4) before the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

4. Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a

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direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar that in case the petitioners file a representation before him within a week seeking protection of their lives and liberty, in that case, he shall decide the said representation of the petitioners, in accordance with law, and grant them protection, if any threat to their lives and liberty is perceived.

6. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them. This order would not be understood having expressed any opinion whatsoever by this Court on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners.
