Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 is for issuance of directions to the official respondent to take strict legal action against respondents No.4 to 6 and further for issuance of direction to decide representation dated 27.01.2025 (Anneuxre P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that in order to grab the property of the deceased, namely Vishavjeet, father of the petitioner, private respondents by forging some documents, in connivance with one another got sanctioned mutation of deceased Vishavjeet in favour of respondent No.4 and her children. Copy of Aadhar Card of respondent No.4-Raj Kumari Chauhan, has also been placed on record, wherein she has been shown as wife of Amar Singh, but in the mutation Annexure P1, she has been shown as widow of late Vishavjeet.

During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he would be satisfied if the representation dated 27.01.2025 (Annexure P-3), which had already been moved before respondent No.2 by the petitioner is looked into.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Gagandeep Kaur, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice and submitted that she has no objection if the aforesaid representation dated 27.01.2025 (Annexure P-3) is looked into.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to look into the representation and to take appropriate action, if any required at the earliest.
