The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.224 dated 08.07.2022 under Section 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Sector 14, Gurugram, District Gurugram, Haryana and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom. Petitioner further prays for staying the proceeding of the Investigating Agency/trial Court.

2. Learned counsel for the State submits that the investigation is complete and final report is ready but it has not been filed. He further submits that petitioner has been exonerated and will be kept in column No.2 in case, final report is filed.
