YASHVIR SINGH RATHOR, J. (Oral)

1. The present revision petition has been filed by the petitioner against impugned judgment dated 22.12.2022 vide which he was held guilty and convicted and sentenced to undergo imprisonment for one month besides compensation of Rs.1 lakh as well as judgment dated 06.06.2024, passed by the Appellate Authority vide which appeal preferred against judgment dated 22.12.2022 was dismissed.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over a sum of Rs.80,000/- by way of a demand draft to the complainant and complainant submits that he has no objection in case the offence is allowed to be compounded.



3. The offence under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 (for short ‘NI Act’) can be compounded at any stage and since the dispute has been settled amicably and entire amount stands paid, the prayer for compounding the offence is allowed. Resultantly, the impugned judgments dated 22.12.2022 and 06.06.2024 are set aside and accused is acquitted of the charge under Section 138 of NI Act.
4. Present petition stands disposed of.
5. Pending misc. application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
