Challenge in the present petition is to the impugned order dated 05.07.2014 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.2-Managing Director, Punjab National Bank, New Delhi, whereby Leave Encashment benefit to the petitioner has been declined.

Counsel for the respondents-Bank submits that the issue involved in the present writ petition is covered in the judgment dated 06.11.2023 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in ***Civil Appeal No. 6611-2015 titled as "Jyotirmay Ray versus the Field General Manager, Punjab National Bank and others"*** in which the respondents were directed to comply with the same and release the

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outstanding amount to the petitioner in accordance with law within three months.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of in terms of the judgment dated 06.11.2023 passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in ***Civil Appeal No. 6611-2015***. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to approach this Court and seek the revival in case any cause of action survives.
