By way of the present writ petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the official respondents to hand over the physical possession of the residential plot No.299, Sector-52, Gurugram after completion of all development workds/basic amenities.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already made a representation dated 05.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) to the competent authority for redressal of her grievances, but no action has been taken thereon till date. He further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the respondent authorities are directed to deal with her concerns/grievances and pass appropriate order on the said application.



3. Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Gaurav Bansal, DAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State, whereas Mr. Ankur Mittal, Advocate, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-HSVP and submits that the said representation shall be considered and decided by the competent authority, in accordance with law.
4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 (competent authority), to look into the pending representation dated 05.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner and pass an appropriate reasoned order thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order.
5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
