On 19.05.2025, the following order was passed by this
Court:-

“Prayer in this criminal writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of detenue namely Priya, daughter of the petitioner, from the illegal detention of respondent No.7. Further prayer has been made to direct respondents No.3 and 6 to search the place of respondent No.7 and ensure release of the detenue from the illegal custody of respondent No.7 and to produce the detenue before this Court. Another prayer has been made to direct respondents No.1 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner and detenue at the hands of respondent No.7.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rishabh Singla, AAG, Punjab who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent – State and seeks a short accommodation to file status report.



Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a copy of paperbook to counsel for the State during course of the day.

Adjourned to 26.05.2025.”

In compliance thereof, status report by way of affidavit of Bharat Bhushan, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Phagwara, District Kapurthala, has been filed in the Court today, which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that the present petition is totally misconceived. The detinue in question is daughter of the petitioner, who is major and she had made a categoric statement that she is married with respondent No.7 with her own consent and the petitioner is not happy with her marriage and is filing false and frivolous application against the detinue and her husband. Further, the detinue has submitted an application against the petitioner.

In view of the status report, no further directions are required to be passed.

Disposed of accordingly.
