1. Present petition under Sections 12 and 10 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 has been filed by the petitioner for wilful and deliberate disobedience of the order dated 27.03.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in case bearing No.CRM-M-14952-2025 titled '*Raj Prehar vs. State of Punjab and others*'.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent has not decided the representation dated 10.10.2024 in terms of the order dated 27.03.2025 (Annexure P-1), as such he is liable to be proceeded against for Contempt of Court due to wilful and deliberate disobedience of the said order.
3. On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that there is no disobedience of the order passed by this Court. In fact the representation dated

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10.10.2024 was received in the office of Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar. Preliminary enquiry was conducted and report dated 24.12.2024 was sent by the Special Investigation Team before the office of Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar.

4. Learned State counsel submits that the copy of the said report would be supplied to the petitioner within 7 days from today.

5. Learned State counsel further informed that no action on the said representation could be taken on account of the order dated 21.05.2025 (Annexure R-1) passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-21458-2025 in CRM-M-9313-2025 filed by respondent-Jarnail Singh Bajwa in CRM-M-14952-2025, wherein 4 months time was granted to the said Jarnail Singh Bajwa for settling the disputes in the remaining 23 complaints.

6. It is further submitted that appropriate action shall be taken after the expiry of the said time.

7. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition be disposed of at this stage.

8. Prayer is accepted.

9. Disposed of accordingly.
