1. Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') read with Section 528 of BNSS for grant of interim bail to the petitioner for a period of two months in FIR No.2 dated 09.01.2022 under Sections 302, 307, 325, 326, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Urban Estate, District Patiala on the ground that his father is suffering from gangrene.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that father of the petitioner is in critical condition, as his right foot has been amputated

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and procedure for amputation of left foot is recommended. There is no other member in the family of the petitioner to look after his father and make necessary arrangements for his treatment, as mother of the petitioner had already died on 24.10.2020.

4. *Per contra*, learned State counsel, on instructions from SHO, Police Station Urban Estate, Patiala, submits that the averments made by the petitioner with regard to health of his father have been duly verified. There is no member in the family of the petitioner. Further, health condition of father of the petitioner is critical and he is being looked after by neighbours and requires immediate surgery.

5. Keeping in view the above, present petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail for a period of two months from the date of his release, on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court concerned.

6. The petitioner will surrender before the jail authorities on expiry of interim bail.
