This petition under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS, 2023) has been filed seeking direction to respondent No.2 to carry out fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.23 dated 06.02.2025, under Sections 137(2) and 96 BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Sahnewal, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana against the private respondent and to take action on her representation dated 29.04.2025 (Annexure P4).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed a representation dated 29.04.2025 (Annexure P4) before respondent No.2 raising her grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereupon. He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if, appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereupon.

4. Served with an advance copy of the petition, Ms. Guramrit Kaur, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 29.04.2025 (Annexure P4) of the petitioner expeditiously, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
6. Needless to say, if any threat perception is found to the petitioner, the official respondents would provide her adequate security in order to protect her life and liberty.
