SANJAY VASHISTH. J.(Oral)

1. Present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioners by assessing the perception of threats from the hands of respondents No.5 to 11.

2. Learned State counsel informs that considering the complaint of petitioner, one FIR No.61 dated 23.10.2024, under Sections 125, 194(2), 191(3), 190, 324(5) of BNS, registered at Police Station Hajipur, District Hoshiapur has already been registered against the accused persons and later on they were released on bail.

3. In case there is any apprehension to the petitioners at the instance of the private respondents, it would be open for the petitioners to seek cancellation of

bail by citing the incident in specific.

4. In view of the fact that the grievance of the petitioners has already been redressed by the official respondent, there remains no purpose in issuing any direction in the instant petition, as prayed for by the petitioner.
5. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
