1. Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023, is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.5 dated 20.02.2025, registered under Sections 318(4) of the BNS, 2023 (Section 61(2) of the BNS added later on), at Police Station Cyber Crime Sangrur, District Sangrur.

2. Vide order dated 23.05.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 23.05.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.



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5. In view of the above, interim order dated 23.05.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) B.N.S.S.

6. Petition stands allowed.
