1. Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondents to revise the pay and pension of the petitioner by granting the scale of Rs.3000-4500/- w.e.f. 01.01.1986 and scale of Rs.3700-5000/- w.e.f. 28.10.1994.

2. Learned counsel submits that the issue involved in the present case with regard to the revision and pension of the petitioner, is squarely covered by the judgment dated 11.09.2013 (Annexure P-7) passed in **Manoj Kumar vs. Punjab School Education Board**, CWP-7899-1998 and connected case, which has attained finality and even stands implemented. He thus, at this stage, on instructions, prays that a direction is given to the respondents to consider the matter taking note of

the aforesaid judgment, in a time bound manner, to which learned counsel for the respondents have no objection.

3. In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the claim of the petitioner, within a period of 4 months, taking note of the aforesaid judgment, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to him and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to his interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioner shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
