1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.47 dated 14.05.2024 registered under Sections 376-D, 506, 323 & 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Cantt. Ferozepur.

2. Status report by way of an affidavit of Sh. Sukhwinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), District Ferozepur, on behalf of the respondent-State, filed in the Registry is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and the prosecutrix and co-accused namely Rajeshwar has also been granted regular bail by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge (Fast Track Court,



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exclusively dealing with rape cases), Ferozepur, vide order dated 01.08.2025. He further submits that since there is a change of circumstances, he wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the Court below by filing 2nd application for grant of anticipatory bail.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
