SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing the official respondents nos.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent no.4 to 7.

Learned State counsel submits that a speaking order dated 21.05.2025 has been passed on the representation submitted by the petitioners. A copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioners. The relevant part of the order read as under:-

“During the investigation the petitioner Anshu Rani's phone number 99143- 84945 was called but the phone was switched off, on which ASI Khushia Singh 1305/FZR arrived at the house petitioner Sajan Singh son of Veer Singh resident of village Attuwala Hithar where the house of Sajan Singh was locked, in this regard the mobile number of the village sarpanch Paramjit Singh 99148-44209 was coordinated

He said that they have not come home after getting married and neither have they been seen anywhere around to come home. If we see anyone from them we will inform you.

After which ASI Khushia Singh reached the petitioner Anshu Rani's house where Ansh Rani's father Balkar Singh was present in the house who told that my daughter Anshu Rani has arranged a love marriage of her own free will. We don't know where she is living, we have no objection to her marriage wherever she wants. He himself is responsible.

Consideration above the facts and circumstances specially the statement of girl's father he has no objection to the marriage and also as the petitioner are themselves are unreachable the present representation file accordingly.

If the petitioner is not satisfied with this order, then he can file his appeal with the Deputy Superintendent of Police (Crime against Women and Children) Ferozepur within three days. The Copy of this order has been sent to the petitioners on Whatsapp ”

In the light of above, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail alternate remedy by way of appeal as per notification No.HOME-HM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch).
