By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS,
2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR as under:

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
57	05.04.2023	307, 506, 148, 149, 427 of IPC, 1860	Dugri, District Ludhiana, Punjab.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 23.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 23.05.2025.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagdish, intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.
4. During the course of hearing on 23.05.2025, following order was passed:



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“2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He further contends that no injury or specific overt act is attributed to the petitioner in the alleged occurrence. He contends that even during the course of the proceedings, the matter has since been compromised with the complainant-victim vide compromise Annexure P-2. He submits that the petitioner is having no criminal antecedents and is ready to join the investigation. Hence, the present petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Roshandeep Singh, AAG, Punjab, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent and has not disputed the factual matrix of the case.

5. Mr. Atul Kumar, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and 3 and filed memo of appearance, which is taken on record. He has categorically stated that he is having specific instructions on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 to say that they have no objection in case the petitioner is granted concession of bail as compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily. He seeks time to file power of attorney. The same be filed on or before the next date of hearing.

6. Adjourned to 01.07.2025.

7. Needful be done well before the date fixed with an advance copy to the counsel opposite.

8. In the meanwhile, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He



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shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.

9. Investigating Officer of the case to remain present along with record on the next date of hearing.”

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 23.05.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 23.05.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.

7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
