1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 with a prayer to grant regular bail to him in case FIR No.06 dated 16.01.2025, registered under Sections 333, 118(2), 117(2), 115(2), 3(5) BNS Act, Police Station Valtaha, District Tarn Taran.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that both the parties in the present case are closely related to each other and are immediate neighbours also. Even the fight taken place over a trivial issue of sharing of common wall by both the parties. Learned counsel further contents that in the present case Charanjit Kaur, injured had suffered two grievous injuries, however, she has already been discharged from the hospital and she is hale and hearty. The petitioner was arrested in the present case on 28.03.2025 and is in custody for



the last 02 months. Even the recoveries have already been effected from him and the investigation is almost complete.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that serious allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner and he does not deserve the concession of bail by this Court.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

5. In the present case, all the offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate and the petitioner is stated to be in custody for the last two months. Even the injured has been discharged from the hospital. Thus, the further custody of the petitioner will not serve any useful purpose.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.
