The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuing direction with limited prayer to the Court of Additional Sessions Judge for expeditious disposal of application (P-7) filed alongwith Criminal Revision No.68/2022 titled 'Darshan Kumar @ Happy vs. Gaurav Bansal' (P-6) for staying the proceedings of Criminal Complaint No.COMA/741/2020 (NACT-3890-2020).

2. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, issuance of notice of motion is not deemed necessary in the light of nature of prayer made which is confined to a direction to Additional Sessions Judge for expeditious disposal of application (P-7) alongwith Criminal Revision No.68/2022 titled 'Darshan Kumar vs. Gaurav Bansal' (P-6).

3. Since the criminal revision petition is pending from 2022, without adverting to the merits and issue involved wherein three years have gone by, learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda is directed to decide the above said application (P-7) within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. However, learned counsel for the petitioner does
