1. Prayer made in the present petition is for quashing the inaction of the respondents with regard to the application submitted by the petitioner for appointment on compassionate grounds, and for releasing the amount of dues regarding gratuity, leave encashment and other benefits.

2. Learned counsel submits that the husband of the petitioner was working as Class-IV Employee with respondent No.3 and insofar as the first relief is concerned, seeks liberty to avail of alternate remedy, that may be available, in accordance with law.

3. Ordered accordingly.

4. However, with regard to the balance amount of the retiral benefits, he submits that the said respondent-School may take a decision and convey the same and in case, any amount is found due, it be released, to which learned counsel for respondent No.3 has no objection.
