This petition has been filed under Section 528 of the BNSS 2023, read with Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ/directions in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate direction restraining the respondent-police from intimidating and harassing the petitioner and infringing on their Constitutional right to life and liberty by unleashing the entire state police machinery at the behest of respondent no.4- an influential and powerful liquor distributor of Punjab who has managed to mobilise entire police teams to call, emails incessantly, without any copy of the complaint or allegations, at odd hours every day right after

the petitioner issued a notice under the Negotiable Instruments Act against respondent no.4.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant case with liberty to approach the appropriate authority as per law.

Allowed as prayed for.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty afore-said.
