VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J (ORAL)

The instant writ petition had been filed challenging the order dated 19.11.2013 (Annexure P-4) passed by the respondents/Bank whereby the application of the petitioner for employment on compassionate grounds was dismissed.

2 It is evident from a perusal of the zimni orders that vide order dated 29.01.2016, the matter was adjourned to 03.08.2016 on the request of

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counsel for the petitioner. On the said date, a written request for an adjournment was circulated on behalf of the counsel for the petitioner. On the adjourned date i.e. 21.10.2016, there was no appearance on behalf of the petitioner due to which the matter was adjourned to 09.11.2016 on which date, yet again, a request was made on behalf of the petitioner and the matter was adjourned to 05.04.2017. The case was adjourned yet again to 27.09.2017 and then to 22.01.2018 by an office order. On 22.01.2018, the counsel for the petitioner again sought an adjournment due to which the matter was adjourned *sine die*. No request for listing of the case was made on behalf of the petitioner over a period of nearly 07 years. Even today, when the matter is being taken up for hearing, and as per office report, the counsel for the petitioner had been informed, yet, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

3 It seems that the petitioner does not intend to pursue the case any further.

4 Dismissed for non-prosecution.
