The present misc. applications have been filed by the petitioner for seeking disposal of the main writ petition which has been adjourned sine die and ordered to be listed after the decision in CWP-22592-2015 vide order dated 05.03.2020, in terms of the judgment ***dated 13.03.2024 passed in CWP-2158-2020 titled as 'Ashish Sharma and***

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others Vs. State of Haryana and others along with other connected matters.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner submits that the issue involved in the present writ petition has been put to rest by the judgment passed by the Single Judge of this Court in the above said writ petition and the **LPA No.2683 of 2024 titled as 'State of Haryana and others Vs. Ashishi Sharma and others'** preferred by the State of Haryana assailing the order passed by the learned Single has also been dismissed vide **judgment dated 06.11.2024**.

Learned State counsel does not dispute that the controversy involved in the present writ petition is covered by the judgment passed by the learned Single Judge **dated 13.03.2024 passed in CWP-2158-2020 titled as 'Ashish Sharma and others Vs. State of Haryana and others'** along with other connected matters and that the aforesaid LPA against the order of learned Single Judge also stands dismissed.

In view of above, the present applications are allowed. The main writ petition is taken on board today itself.

Main case

Prayer made in the present writ petition was for seeking setting aside of the order dated 09.04.2014 passed by respondent No.2 - Director Public Relations Department, Haryana, whereby the claim of the

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petitioner regarding ex gratia grant and other financial benefits including family pension and gratuity etc. has been declined.

In view of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner which is not disputed by the learned State counsel, the present writ petition is disposed of in terms of the judgment ***dated 13.03.2024 passed in CWP-2158-2020 titled as 'Ashish Sharma and others Vs. State of Haryana and others'*** along with other connected matters.
