SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

1. Mr. A.P.S. Sehgal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and has filed Memorandum of Appearance, which is taken on record.

2. Instant writ petition has been filed primarily seeking following reliefs:-

“I. Issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order, or direction, directing the respondents to supply the copy of the order of the Appellate Authority that set aside the Awards dated June 4, 2020 (Annexure P-1), and June 8, 2020 (Annexure P-2);

II. Direct the respondents to provide the grounds for the appeal and any related documents or information that will assist the petitioner in understanding the basis of the decision.”

3. During the course of hearing, counsel for respondent No.2 has supplied a copy of order dated 20.07.2021 passed by the appellate authority, whereby awards, Annexures P-1 and P-2, were set aside.
