1. Present Contempt Petition has been filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Section 151 CPC for disobeying and violating of the order dated 17.03.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court.

2. Learned State counsel has filed the status report dated 01.07.2025 in pursuance of the order dated 26.05.2025, which is taken on record and copy of the same has been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner.
