1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 14.05.2018 whereby he was ordered to be retired on attaining the age of 55 years.

2. On 25.05.2018, while issuing notice of motion the operation of impugned order was stayed by this Court.

3. Learned State counsel submits that on account of aforesaid order, the petitioner remained in service till the age of 58 years. He has superannuated, thus, the petition has rendered infructuous.

4. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the present petition stands dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.



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5. The petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application within three months from today if cause survives.
