The Prayer in this petition under Section 483 BNSS is for grant of the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.282 dated 21.12.2024 under Sections 316(2), 318(4), 351(2), 338, 336 (3), 340(2), 238 BNS registered at P.S. Sadar, Ambala.

2. The present FIR came to be registered at the instance of Sita Ram and reads as under:-

“ To, The Superintendent of Police, Ambala. Subject Complaint against Amritpal Singh son of Sh. Madan Lal, Nisha wife of Sh. Amritpal, residents of village Nilokheri, District Karnal, Mobile Number 8814000351, 8813218666 about swindling Rs.16,00000/- in the name of getting a job of clerk in the Hon'ble High Court and issuing fake appointment letter and threatening to kill. Sir, the complainant submits as follows 1. That I, Sita Ram son of Sh. Babu Singh, am a resident of village Lakhnaur Sahib, district Ambala. 2. That the complainant met Amritpal Singh son of Sh. Madan Lal, resident of village Nilokheri, district Karnal in Ambala Jail, when the said Amritpal Singh son of Sh. Madan Lal, Nisha



wife of Sh. Amritpal, residents of village Nilokheri, district Karnal told me that he is posted on the post of Secretary and in the Hon'ble Punjab Haryana High Court and he also told that he is lodged in jail in some case. 3. That the said Amrit Pal told that being a secretary he is in touch with the judges of the High Court and also told that he can get any work done through them. The complainant told that my daughter Shivani is doing B.A., apart from this Vishal who is my nephew is 12th pass, apart from this there are two sons of my friend who are from Bhanokheri, whose names are Pradeep Singh and Hardeep and are educated. When I mentioned this to the said Amrit Pal, he said that I can get these children a job of clerk in the Hon'ble High Court very easily and also told that in return he said that he would take Rs. 8,00000/- per child, for which the deal was fixed for Rs. 32,00000/- for getting jobs for our four children, which we agreed to pay and Amritpal said that he would get them said jobs within 15 days. 4. That the Amritpal Singh son of Sh. Madan Lal, Nisha wife of Sh. Amritpal, residents of village Nilokheri, District Karnal mobile number 8814000351, 8813218666 took Rs.8,50,000/- in cash from our house on 22.07.2024 in front of many people, after a week of that the said Amritpal Singh son of Sh. Madan Lal, Nisha wife of Sh. Amritpal, residents of village Nilokheri, District Karnal, mobile number 8814000351, 8813218666 took our children's Aadhar Card, School Certificate, thus the said photographs etc. from us and said that our children will get jobs soon, Amritpal Singh son of Sh. Madan Lal, Nisha wife of Sh. Amritpal, residents of village Nirlokheri, district Karnal, mobile number 8814000351, 8813218666 took more than Rs. 16,00000/- from us and issued us appointment letters, but when we inquired about those appointment letters, that those found letters are fake and forged and fabricated, on which the said Amritpal Singh son of Sh. wife Nisha of Sh. Amritpal, Madan Lal, residents of village Nirlokheri, district Karnal, Mobile Number 8814000351, 8813218666 have forged the signature of the officer and issued letters of appointment in the name of my daughter Shivani and issued letters of recruitment as clerk in the name of other children, which on being probed, we found that all the letters are fake. 5. That when we called the above Amritpal Singh son of Sh. Madan Lal, Nisha wife of Sh. Amritpal, resident of village Nilokheri, District Karnal, Mobile Number 88140 00351, 8813218666 and told them that these letters are fake and said that you have grabbed our money, they said that we will not return your money, you do whatever you can and also threatened that if we contacted against or called again, they will get us killed. The said people have conspired and usurped more than about Rupees 16 lakhs from us, which we had taken on a hefty interest amount and gave hard-earned money our usurped our earnings and and they have they now are



threatening to kill us. Therefore, you are requested to take action against Amritpal Singh son of Sh. Madan Lal, Nisha wife of Sh. Amritpal, residents village Nilokheri District Karnal, mobile number 8814000351, 8813218666 for usurping Rs. 16,00000/- in the name of getting the job of clerk in the Hon'ble High Court and for issuing fake appointment letters and threatening to kill. You will be very kind. Thank you. Sd/ Sita Ram."

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. The allegations are completely vague. The petitioner is neither an employee of the High Court nor has she any connection with any other employee. It is highly improbable that someone would pay Rs.32 lacs in connection with employment. The liability if any is of Amritpal Singh husband of the petitioner. As the petitioner is in custody since 24.01.2025, but none of the 31 prosecution witnesses has been examined so far, the trial of the present case is not likely to be concluded anytime soon and therefore, she is entitled to the concession of bail.

4. The learned counsel for the State on the other hand contends that the allegations levelled against the petitioner and her husband are very serious. They have cheated the complainant of a huge amount of money on the pretext that they would provide employment to the family members of the complainant. Keeping in view the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioner, she is not entitled to the concession of bail. He however concedes that the petitioner is in custody since 24.01.2025 and that none of the 31 has been examined so far.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

6. The veracity of the prosecution case against the petitioner and his co-accused shall be adjudicated upon during the course of the trial. Admittedly, the petitioner is in custody since 24.01.2025 and none of the 31



prosecution witnesses has been examined so far. Therefore, the Trial of the present case is not likely to be concluded anytime soon. Hence, the further incarceration of the petitioner is not warranted.

7. Thus without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner-**Nisha** wife of Sh. Amritpal Singh is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

8. The petitioner shall appear before the police station concerned on the first Monday of every month till the conclusion of the trial and inform in writing each time that she is not involved in any other crime other than the cases mentioned in this order.

9. If the petitioner or any of her family members/associates make any attempt to contact/threaten/intimidate the witnesses in the present case, the State would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of bail granted vide this Court.

10. In addition, the petitioner (or anyone on her behalf) shall prepare an FDR in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- and deposit the same with the Trial Court. The same would be liable to be forfeited as per law in case of the absence of the petitioner from the trial without sufficient cause.

11. The petition stands disposed of.
