The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents authorities to reinstate the petitioner in service with immediate effect.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this juncture, the petitioner would be satisfied in case the respondent No.2-General Manager, Canara Bank, Chandigarh is directed to treat this petition as a representation and to consider the grievance espoused by the petitioner therein by passing a speaking order thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.



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3. Counsel for the respondents-Bank has no objection, if the aforesaid prayer is accepted.

4. Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and respondent No.2-General Manager, Canara Bank, Chandigarh is directed to treat this petition as a representation and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
