Status report dated 02.10.2024 filed by way of affidavit of Surendra Lamba, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 had already been taken on record vide order dated 04.11.2024.

In the aforesaid status report para No.5, it has been mentioned that that initial investigation of FIR No.49 was conducted by SI Nirmal Singh No.134/ Jal(2) and ASI Om Parkash No.1200/HSP and both investigating officers without taking any opinion regarding injury from doctor and without any scientific and technical investigation, added Sections 307/506 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act and thus, these investigating officers were found to be negligent in performing their duties and thus, SP (Investigation), Hoshiarpur vide his report dated

28.09.2024, recommended for taking departmental action against SI Nirmal Singh No.134/ Jal(2) and ASI Om Parkash No.1200/HSP and on the basis of said recommendation, departmental action has been ordered to be initiated by deponent i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur vide order No.6217-24/PA, dated 28.09.2024.

In para No.6 of the status report, it has been mentioned that in order to ensure safety and security of the petitioners, grievance of the petitioners was heard during enquiry proceedings of SP (Investigation), Hoshiarpur and statement of petitioner No.1 was recorded and further proceedings for maintaining peace was initiated against Sahil Sehdev under Sections 126/ 169 of BNSS vide DDR No.40 dated 25.09.2024. The petitioners were provided with phone numbers of SP (Investigation), Hoshiarpur, DSP, Tanda (Hoshiarpur), SHO Police Station Ghardiwala, District Hoshiarpur and Police Control Room and they were asked to contact senior officer immediately, if any situation of threat arises. Further, police officials posted at Police Station Ghardiwala were directed to increase vigil outside the house/ residence of the petitioners with help of PCR teams and officials of Special Branch with SOP in place which guides about the requirement of the security to a person apprehending threat. It has been mentioned that all the requirement of the said SOP's are being followed in letter and spirit and the SHO concerned has been directed to review the threat perception of the petitioners vigilantly and to take appropriate action in providing security, if so required.

As the present petition has been filed by the petitioners for protection of their life and liberty and as per the status report, all the

necessary security measures have already been taken regarding the same and as such, the present petition has become infructuous.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, the petitioner will be at liberty to file a new petition, if so required.
