SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondent-bank has drawn the attention of this Court through an e-mail dated 21.08.2025, which is to the following effect:-

“With reference to the trailing mail, the party had cleared entire outstanding in the loan account 81509780000029 in the name of Smt. Pallavi Sharma. The total closure amount deposited in loan account 81509780000029 on 21.08.2025 is Rs.25,79,829.25/-. Hence account (81509780000029) closed in Canara Bank.

Therefore we wish to inform you that on receipt of above amount we have withdrawn the auction dated 25.08.2025 but we will be unable to release the said property since there are indirect liabilities (M/s Eagleline Fixing, M/s Multiple Overseas Exports) of mortgagor and guarantors in Canara Bank.

This is for your information”.



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2. For ready reference and convenience, the said e-mail dated 21.08.2025 is taken on record as (Annexure-X).

3. In view of the aforesaid stand of the respondent-bank present petition stands disposed of, with liberty to the petitioner-borrower to revisit the Court, in case any of the grievance remains unaddressed.

4. With the aforesaid liberty, the present petition stands disposed of.

5. All pending Civil Miscellaneous application(s) stand disposed of accordingly.
