The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the petitioner all notional benefits including fixation of pay and seniority from the date his juniors have been appointed, i.e., May, 2015.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the law in this regard stands settled by this Court in CWP-14426-2016 titled *Sudesh Kumari v. Haryana School Shiksha Pariyojna Parishad and another*. Still, the petitioner's claim has not been considered, nor has his legal notice, dated 30.11.2018, Annexure P-8, been decided so far.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Rathee, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent no.1/State. Mr. Sanjeev Kaushik, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.2/Parishad and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 30.11.2018, will be decided by the second respondent/State Project Director, Haryana School Shiksha Pariyojna Parishad, by passing a speaking order thereupon within a period of three months, keeping in view the law laid down in *Sudesh Kumari* case (*supra*).

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- 5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
- 6. Ordered accordingly.
- 7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
