1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the charge-sheet dated 07.08.2015 (Annexure P-5) issued by respondent No.2 and order dated 07.08.2015 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.2 vide which, the case of the petitioner for voluntary retirement from service from the post of Math Mistress has been rejected.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present writ petition, the respondents have passed the order of compulsory retirement dated 28.01.2025 in pursuance to the enquiry initiated on the basis of charge-sheet dated 07.08.2015. Learned counsel submits that in view of the order dated 28.01.2025, he does not want to press the present writ petition with the liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order dated 28.01.2025 in accordance with law.

3. In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as not pressed with liberty, as prayed for.
