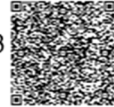

(1) Through this petition the petitioner seeks extension in the parole granted to him.

(2) Through order dated 28.03.2025, passed by the Additional Superintendent, Central Jail, Kapurthala, the petitioner was granted parole for 56 days. Such parole was granted to enable the petitioner to meet his family members. The petitioner was to surrender on 22.05.2025. However, before the day of his surrender, the instant petition was filed seeking therein extension in the period of parole for a period of four weeks on the ground



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that the petitioner's mother is unwell and that there is no one else to take care of her.

(3) Notice of the petition was issued to the State, in response whereof learned State counsel submits that on verification made by the State it has been revealed that the petitioner's mother is in fact unwell but the averment made by the petitioner that there is no one else to take care of her is not correct as four other brothers of the petitioner are very much available to take care of his mother.

(4) After considering the above rival claims and the record, we dispose of this petition by directing the extension of parole to the petitioner till 29.05.2025.

(5) It is clarified that the petitioner shall surrender on 30.05.2025 by 10:00 a.m.
