Prayer in this application is for placing on record documents Annexures P-5 and P-6.

2 Allowed as prayed for. Documents as Annexures P-5 and P-6 are taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

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Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to official respondents to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioners, who are in live-in-relationship against the wishes of private respondents No.4 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners are major, petitioner No.1 – Neetu, aged 21 years, and petitioner No.2 – Akash Babu, aged 20 years and 11 months, are in live-in-relationship with each other. The petitioners seek protection to their life and liberty. They

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apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 8. Hence, they are seeking protection in that regard and have approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition. The copies of Aadhaar card of petitioners (Annexures P-1 and P-2) have been placed on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has relied upon a judgment of this Court in **CWP No.31834 of 2019** titled as “**Megha and another vs. State of Haryana and others**” decided on 04.11.2019 and submitted that this Court had entertained petition for protection of couples in live-in relationship.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court Mr. Arjun Lakhanpal, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

At this stage, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case as well as nature of relationship between the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 19.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) at the earliest and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents. However, this direction will have no effect on any civil or criminal action, which could be initiated in the matter in accordance with law.
