The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner(s) in case bearing FIR No.446 dated 23.12.2024, under Section(s) 110, 115, 190, 191 (2) 351 (2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 registered at Police Station Sector 65, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

2 Status report already filed on behalf of the respondent State is taken on record.

3 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 26.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner(s) has joined investigation and is no longer required for investigation of the case.

4            Learned State counsel, on instruction, corroborates the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner(s) is not required for the purpose of investigation.

5            Heard learned counsel for the parties.

6            Since the petitioner(s) has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 26.05.2025 is made absolute.

7            However, the petitioner(s) shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
