Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to decide the appeal dated 21.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioner before respondent No.2 – Director, State Transport Haryana, Chandigarh,

Learned arguing counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was inducted as Conductor with Haryana Roadways and was promoted as Sub Inspector w.e.f. 15.01.2021 vide order dated 31.03.2023. The petitioner, however, came to know that his ACR for the year 2006-2007 was reported as “Average”. He further submits that the said ACR has never been conveyed to the petitioner. Moreover, the entire service record of the petitioner has remained unblemished and there has never been any complaint or case against the petitioner. Aggrieved of the said remarks in the ACR, the petitioner preferred an appeal dated 21.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) before respondent No.2 – Director, State Transport Haryana, Chandigarh, but the said respondent has been sitting over the matter and has not taken any decision thereupon till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rahul Dev, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice and assure that the Competent Authority/respondent No.2 shall look into the grievance of the petitioner and decide the appeal dated 21.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) as expeditiously as possible.

Counsel for the petitioner agrees to the said arrangement, but prays for directing the respondent-Authority to decide the appeal in a time bound manner.

Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of while directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the appeal dated 21.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of four months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.
