The petitioner has approached this Court seeking directions to the respondents to consider and approve the compassionate transfer of Constable Tailor Shri Satyaveer (CT-TLR), presently posted at GC-Pinjore, Haryana to a unit near Delhi (preferably Sonapat).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this juncture, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.2-the Director General, Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), CGO Complex, New Delhi is directed to decide the letter/representation dated 24.04.2025 (Annexure P-5) and the grievance espoused by the petitioner

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therein by passing a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Rakesh Verma, Senior Panel Counsel appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and respondent No.2-the Director General, Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), CGO Complex, New Delhi, is directed to decide the letter/representation dated 24.04.2025 (Annexure P-5) and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
