1. In the present petition, the claim of the petitioner is that though, the petitioner has already cleared the BA LL.B. Examination from the respondent No.3-Institute and even the details of the marksheet have been mentioned in the present petition but still, the Degree of BA. LL.B. is not being granted to the petitioner without any valid justification.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance being raised by the petitioner in the present petition has already been raised in the representation dated 08.01.2025, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-6 but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a

direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Sanjeev Roy, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, the representation dated 08.01.2025 (Annexure P-6) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of **eight weeks** from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.
