The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the official respondents to register an FIR and further to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in the matter and to take action on their representation dated 21.04.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2 to decide or take necessary action on the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner raising his grievances which has not been considered and no action has been taken till now.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Himani Arora, A.A.G, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the



needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid representation dated 21.04.2025 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of one month from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
