1. The present petition has been filed by a married couple seeking protection to their life and personal liberty by providing adequate security and police protection and also to direct respondent Nos.4 to 9 not to interfere in their personal life and liberty.

2. Learned State counsel points out that as per the short reply filed by the State, the statement of petitioner No.1 (Harjinder Singh) has already been recorded. Both the petitioners have already solemnized their marriage and presently are living happily. It has also been further assured through the short reply that protection of life and liberty of the petitioners is the prime concern of the police authorities of Amritsar (Rural) and also ensured that necessary action would be taken immediately at the time of the need to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. Respondent No.3-SHO, Police Station Ajnala, Amritsar (Rural) has prepared its report dated 01.10.2024 and same is appended as (Annexure R-2/T) with the status report.

3. In view of the above, statement of petitioner No.1 has already been recorded (as stated in the short reply) to the effect that they do not have any threat from anyone so they do not require any police protection, the present petition is disposed of, as no cause survives to continue with the proceedings.
