The present application has been filed by the applicant/petitioner under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for impleading the complainant Malkeet Singh S/o Jagtar Singh as respondent No.2 in the main petition.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed.

Malkeet Singh S/o Jagtar Singh is ordered to be impleaded as respondent No.2/complainant.

Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

Main case

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.26 dated 27.04.2025, under Sections 316(2), 318(4) and 61(2) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 25.09.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to



order dated 25.09.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and deposited a sum of Rs.37,500/- and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 25.09.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

Petition stands allowed.
