1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking directions to respondents to release his retiral dues as well as salary from July’ 2021 to April’ 2022.
2. The petitioner claims that he retired on 31.07.2024 on attaining the age of superannuation. Till date he has not been released retiral dues. The respondent is bound to release his retiral dues as early as possible.
3. Mr. Guninder Singh Brar, Advocate, who on advance notice is present in Court on behalf of respondent No.4, assures the Court that outstanding dues, if found to be payable, would be released within three months from today.
4. In the wake of statement of learned counsel for respondent No.4, the present petition stands disposed of.
