The indolent and lackadaisical approach of the Animal Attack / Accident Compensation Committee Mansa-cum- Deputy Commissioner, Mansa, in not deciding the claim of the petitioners as filed vide application (Form-A) dated 02.04.2025 (Annexure P-4) regarding the death of son/ father/ husband of petitioners namely Randhir Singh, propelled them to file the instant petition for seeking mandamus upon respondent No.2, to decide the application in a time bound manner.

Mr. Teevar Sharma, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State, and submits that he has no objection, in case, the asked for *mandamus* is passed upon the respondents, same being *innocuous* and *bona fide*.
