1. The petitioners through instant petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 are seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to handover the investigation to some independent agency like CBI etc. in case having FIR No.17 dated 01.03.2025 registered under Sections 125, 191(3), 190 of BNS, 2023 and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

In compliance of order dated 02.09.2025, status report by way of an affidavit of Inderjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-division Rajasansi, Amritsar (Rural), filed on behalf of the State is taken on record, according to which the cross-case has been registered against the opposite party.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he is satisfied with the steps taken by the police and does not wish to pursue the petition further.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is hereby disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
