The instant petition has been filed for directing respondent No.3 from passing orders repeatedly for change of investigating officer alongwith a further prayer for directing respondent No.6 to expeditiously conclude the investigation in case bearing FIR No.51 dated 23.06.2023 under Sections 323, 341, 324, 427, 452 and 506 (Sections 326 and 307 added later on) of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Sanaur, District Patiala.

The matter came up for hearing on 11.07.2024 when this Court, after noticing that there was probably a soft paddling of the issue by the Investigating Agency issued notice to the respondent-accused.

On resumed hearing, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Dharam Singh informs that the investigation in the matter is already concluded and a final report stands filed against respondent No.9 on 22.04.2025.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
