The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in a case bearing FIR No.2 dated 09.01.2020 under Sections 10, 7A of the Haryana Development & Regulation of Urban Areas Act, 1975 and Sections 120-B, 201, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC and Section 13(D) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered at Police Station ACB, Karnal, District Anti Corruption Bureau, Haryana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 28.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The Additional Affidavit of Virender Singh Sangwan, HPS, Superintendent of Police, State Vigilance & Anti Corruption Bureau, Karnal Range, Karnal dated 25.07.2025 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is



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taken on record. The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 28.05.2025 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 28.05.2025 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
