KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. This Court vide order dated 13.10.2025, imposed a cost of Rs.10,000/- upon respondent no.2, in each petition.
2. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over three separate demand drafts dated 28.10.2025, each amounting to Rs.10,000/- drawn in favour of respondent no.2 in each petition. A photocopy of the same is retained in the respective case files.
3. On the oral request of both the parties, main case being taken up, today itself.

Main case.

4. Both learned counsel for the parties, after arguing for some time, are *ad idem* that earlier a similar issue has already been decided in **“D.B.Corp. Ltd. & Another vs. Davinder Kumar & Another”** (CWP-21171-2024, decided on 19.09.2024), where through, the matter was remanded to the Industrial Tribunal concerned, for reconsideration on the issue of classification.
5. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that other legal issues, as raised in the instant petition, which are supported by a judgment rendered by this Court in CWP-22568-2025 titled as **“Dainik Bhaskar Corporation Ltd. vs. Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal-**



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cum-Labour Court, UT, Chandigarh and another,” shall remain open for the petitioner to agitate, in case, he again fetches grievance from the order passed by learned Industrial Tribunal concerned.

6. Learned counsel for the respondent no.2-workman, extends his no objection to the prayer as made by the petitioner.

7. In view of the consensus arrived at between both learned counsel for the parties, the instant matter is **remanded** to the learned Industrial Tribunal concerned, to reconsider the status of the petitioners, *qua* classification in terms of report of Majithia Wage Board.

8. **Disposed of** accordingly.

9. All pending application(s), if any, also stand **disposed** of accordingly.
