Challenge in the present petition is to the action of the respondents in not granting the modified/upgraded ACP i.e. ACPL 13 (GP-6000) w.e.f. 02.01.2019 to the petitioner even though the said benefit has already been granted to similarly placed employees of the respondent-Department, alongwith the other retiral dues to which the petitioner was entitled to on his superannuation on 31.01.2025.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to her grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 18.04.2025 (Annexure P-8) but the respondents have not taken any action thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.2- Director General, Health Department Haryana, General Hospital, Panchkula is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 18.04.2025 (Annexure P-8) submitted by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rahul Dev, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary. He, however, does not have any objection to the above request.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 18.04.2025 by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of four months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that if upon considering the said representation, in case any monetary benefit is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in her favour within a further period of two months.
