1. The petitioner in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus seeking issuance of direction to official respondent No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 12, who are allegedly notorious, land grabbers and anti social elements.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that raising his grievance, the petitioner has moved a representation dated 22.04.2025 (Annexure P-3) before respondent No.3-SHO Police Station, Saha, District Ambala but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Ambala to look into the representation dated 22.04.2025 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner which has been moved before respondent No.3-Station House Officer,



Police Station Saha, District Amabala and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

4. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

5. On asking of the Court, Ms.Ankita Ahuja, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

6. In view of the restricted prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, District Ambala, to look into the representation dated 22.04.2025 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner, which has been moved before respondent No.3-Station House Officer, Police Station Saha, District Amabala and take immediate appropriate action, if required, in accordance with law.
