Challenge in the present petition was to the order dated 03.06.2024 (Annexure P-3) whereby the petitioner was transferred from Sector 8 Branch Chandigarh to Canara Bank NIT Branch, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the respondents-Bank, at the very outset, submits that the present writ petition has become infructuous since the petitioner has been transferred to S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali). He further contends that with regard to the claim of petitioner regarding salary of 55 days being not paid, the same have never been stopped by the bank.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the instant petition, in case the statement of counsel for the respondents-Bank is found to be false or incorrect or any grievance of the petition still remains unredressed.
